

L&T ECC Sharjah selects 8 students from BITS Pilani, Dubai Campus.

The eighth batch of engineers graduating from BITS Pilani, Dubai Campus, the international campus of Birla Institute of Technology and Science, Pilani, India, get attractive placements. Two days ago, The L&T ECC, Sharjah, came for campus placements and selected 8 students - 5 from EEE and 3 from EIE disciplines. A total of 16 students attended the pre-placement talk followed by a written test. Eleven students were short listed for technical interview.

This year, the Campus has received an overwhelming response and attracted more than 40 companies/organizations to recruit graduating engineers. Some of these include: L&T Electrical and Automation, L&T ECC, Petrofac, Redington, Ducab, Fedex, Cluttons, Thyssen Krupp Grundfos, Telematics, Corrosion Technology, Tetrapak, Metadata, San Book Consultancy, Transgulf Electro-Mechanical, ICT Health, Lifecell, Paramount computers, Data Capture Systems etc. These companies interviewed more than 260 students and till now 88 offers have been made for technical as well as managerial posts. Some of these made more than 5 offers while one of them selected 16 students. This year's highest offer has been AED 11000 pm + perks and the average offer has been AED 7000 pm + perks. The visiting teams were highly impressed with the quality of graduates.

For the first time this year, companies from India were also invited for participation in placements and NIIT Technologies has recruited 4 graduates for Delhi, NCR. Some students have secured placements through their own efforts in companies like Ignite Mudra in India, Qatar Airways in Doha, Qatar, and Schlumberger in Saudi Arabia etc. Many students have also secured admissions in UK/US universities for higher studies/MBA/Ph.D.

The Campus Placement Programme (CPP) is organized by the campus for every graduating batch comprising engineering graduates in Electrical & Electronics, Chemical, Mechanical, Electronics & Instrumentation, Mechanical and Biotechnology. IT firms, Multinational conglomerates, Oil Companies, Manufacturing Companies, Logistics and Trading Organizations, all participate in CPP.
